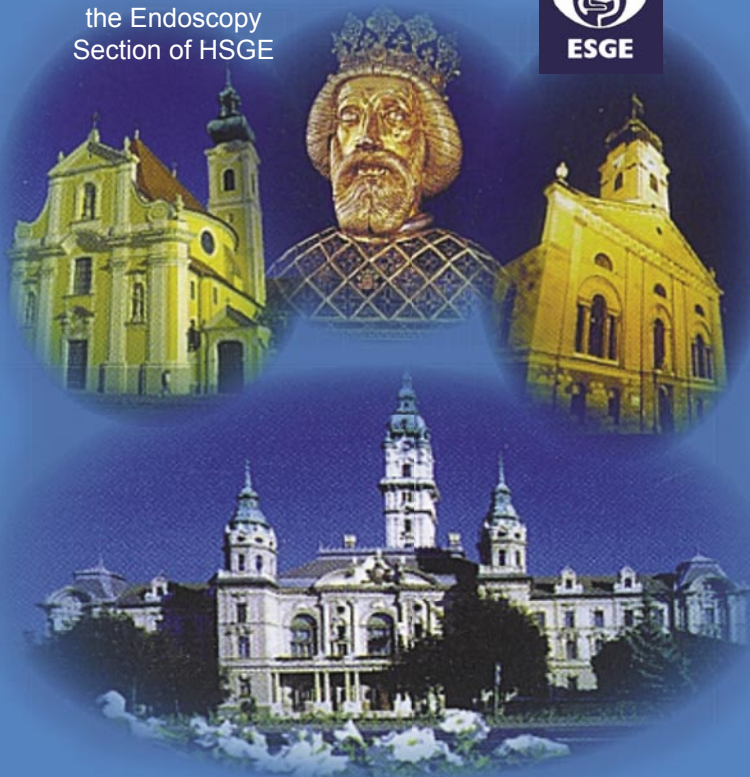

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The Workshop is designed for endoscopists and gastroenterologists but also for physicians in training as well as for nurses and GI assistants.

This course is designed to introduce the participants to the growing field of therapeutic endoscopy, to remind the most current diagnostic problems and to show the new accessories.

It will include live video demonstrations permitting maximal interaction between faculty and attendees during procedures, evidence based didactic comments and lectures.

The procedures will be performed by the international expert endoscopists in collaboration with the experts of local faculty.

Two state-of-the-art lectures will be presented every day and illustrated by live video cases allowing comprehensive didactic sessions on almost all range of diagnostic and therapeutic issues.

The aim of these demonstrations is not only to show the new devices and tricks for succeeding in each type of therapeutic procedure, but above all to explain clearly how to avoid the complications related to therapeutic endoscopy.

MAIN TOPICS AND PROCEDURES

1. Upper digestive tract:

- Diagnostic problems in esogastroduodenoscopy
- Dilatation of esophageal strictures and stenting
- Hemostasis for bleeding ulcers (thermal, injections, clips)
- Watermelon stomach APC treatment
- Hystoacryl treatment of gastric varices
- Band ligation of oesophageal varices
- Echoendoscopy, trans-mural biopsies and punctures
- Enteroscopy, capsule endoscopy
- Percutaneous gastrostomy
- Sessile gastric polyp EUS
- Mucosectomy
- Endoscopic management of GERD
- Endoscopic treatment ofr obesity
- Duodenal stenting
- Chromoendoscopy
- NBI

2. Biliopancreatic diseases:

- Therapeutic ERCP
- Sphincterotomy and stents (biliary and pancreatic)
- Cystenterostomy and EUS guided therapy
- Billroth II and ERCP
- Periampullary polyp ampullectomy

3. Tumors of the colon and IBD:

- Ileocolonoscopy
- Polypectomy
- Mucosectomy
- Dilatation and stenting of strictures
- Ulcerative colitis NBI surveillance
