- Interactive 'mini-clip' video screen

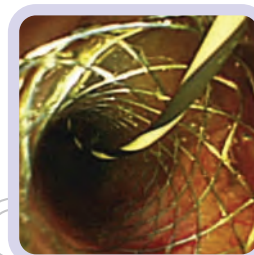
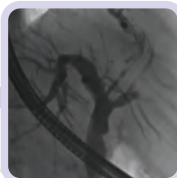

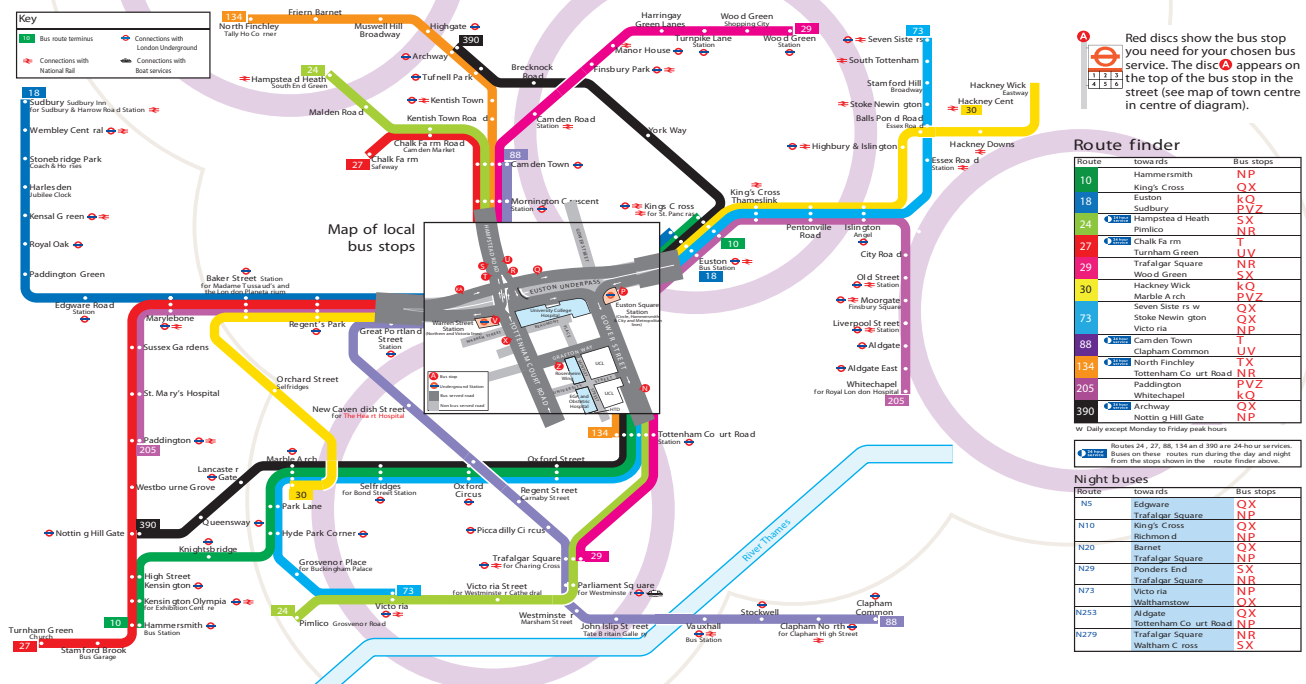
Travel
