GRANT REQUIREMENTS

- Application is open to ESGE Individual Members working in a medical institution within the ESGE zone (Central and Western Europe, Mediterranean and North Africa)
- Applicants should have capsule endoscopy experience
- Applicants should have access to a capsule endoscopy system
- Young researchers will be treated with preference
- The budget must be within the amount awarded to the grant (€ 8,000)
- The award winner will be committed to submitting the report results to Endoscopy
- The award winner will be committed to supplying a study report to ESGE

GRANT BENEFITS

- A substantial number of capsules will be provided, the number determined by the Research Grant Committee* on review of the successful grant application
- Travel expenses and Ethical Committee fees will be covered up to a maximum total value of € 8,000

PREFERRED RESEARCH AREAS

Expanding experience in the use of the PillCam® COLON to complement colonoscopy in various indications such as inflammatory bowel disease (IBD) or when the use of colonoscopy is limited (e.g. in patients with risk related to bleeding or sedation).
