<b>Diagnostic colonoscopies</b>	Basic experience	> 150 independently performed
<b>Basic therapeutic procedures (polypectomy, hemostasis)</b>	Limited or supervised	≥ 30 polypectomies and ≥ 30 hemostasis procedures performed independently
<b>Level of independence</b>	Training level, supervision required	Confident, independent diagnostic endoscopy
<b>Expected competencies</b>	Building foundations in diagnostic and basic therapeutic endoscopy (eg. hemostasis, polypectomy, PEG impl.)	Independently performing basic polypectomy, hemostasis, dilatations; basic management of common endoscopic findings
<b>Suitability</b>	Ideal for those developing core endoscopic skills	Not suitable for beginners or early trainees, designed for endoscopists with ≥3 years of experience who are already performing diagnostic procedures independently and are looking to further develop their skills in EUS and ERCP. If you are working independently and aiming to progress towards therapeutic endoscopy, this course is appropriate for your level.
