

ESGE Event Endorsement policy as of 2025

About ESGE Event Endorsement

The ESGE Event Endorsement recognizes events that adhere to ESGE standards, ensuring the delivery of high-quality scientific programme that are relevant and beneficial to ESGE members.

ESGE considers applications of auditorium-based and/or online live educational events (meetings, courses, workshops, congresses). The ESGE Event Endorsement does not cover webinars, training series at non-consecutive dates, nor university course curricula.

Applications for ESGE Event Endorsement must be made online at [ESGE Event Endorsement Application](#) at least 12 weeks before the event date. Applications submitted less than 12 weeks may not receive the full benefits of ESGE endorsement due to time constraints.

ESGE reserves the right to decline endorsement for events that fail to meet the required criteria or the events that take place during or around ESGE events.

Requirements

To be considered for ESGE Event Endorsement, applications must include the following:

- Detailed information about the scientific programme, including the prominent role of gastrointestinal endoscopy among the topics under discussion. The programme should also incorporate topics related to green endoscopy and sustainability activities
- Summary of the specific educational objectives to be addressed
- Outline of how the course objectives will be achieved and formally assessed
- List of invited faculty members
- List of course sponsors

Approval criteria

- The event should be held under the aegis of either a medical association/society or an academic/clinical institution, and not organized under a commercial entity
- The programme is educational and not designed for commercial purposes
- The role of gastrointestinal endoscopy *must* be prominent
- Including a topic on green endoscopy/ green activity in the programme is encouraged
- At least one ESGE Individual Member should be part of the organizing/scientific committee, or the faculty involved in the course
- Mono-sponsored events are not endorsable
- The event lasts at least one full day
- ESGE favors the use of ESGE guidelines, curricula, or quality documents as part of the educational contents of the course

Benefits

When the ESGE agreed to endorse a course or meeting, the following benefits will be provided:

- ESGE endorsement stamp of approval, underlining the scientific quality of your meeting/congress

- Announcement in the journal *Endoscopy*
- Promotion on the ESGE website, ESGE social media platforms and ESGE newsletters (online and hardcopy)
- Permission to print the ESGE endorsement stamp on your event materials
- Display of promotional materials at ESGE booths

The ESGE Event Endorsement benefits will be implemented upon receipt of the endorsement fee.

Condition

- At least a 20% discount registration fee will be given to ESGE Individual Members participating in the event
- One ESGE endorsement applies to a single event only
- Any publications using the ESGE endorsement stamp must be reviewed by ESGE prior to printing and distribution
- Promotional ESGE digital slide(s) should be displayed in event break slides and/or on digital screens at the event venue.
- In the case of a virtual/web-based meeting, a link to the ESGE website and/or an on-line booth (communicating ESGE membership benefits) will be provided
- ESGE assumes no financial responsibility or liability for the event apart from the one stated below
