A summary of the guidelines is as follows:

- The abstract language is English
- The text should be not more than 300 words
- The title of the abstract should be printed in CAPITAL LETTERS;
 the name(s) of the author(s) should be preceded by the full first name
 (middle name Initial optional) omit titles. The number of authors is unlimited.

Deadline: 15 February 2017

ORAL PRESENTATION

6 best presentation will be selected

Oral papers are allocated 8 minutes presentation time followed by a discussion period of 2 minutes.

POSTER SESSION

50 best posters will be selected and will be allocated for poster exhibition on 23 and 24 March (Maximum dimensions: Length 120 cm, width 90 cm).

GUIDELINES for SPEAKERS

Speakers should deliver and view/check their PowerPoint presentations at the Slide Center. Presentations must be prepared in PowerPoint (MS Windows) and provided on a USB-removable drive. Macintosh presentations cannot be accommodated, unless saved to a PC-formatted USB stick.
