COURSE OBJECTIVES AND DESCRIPTION

Dear Colleague,

It is with great pleasure that we invite you to the **37**th **GEEW**, which is moving on with the established pattern of combining live demonstrations with a direct interaction between the participants, the moderators and the experts performing procedures.

New! The meeting will start on Sunday afternoon, June 16, 2019 with "How I do it " symposia focused on technical tricks from experts (part of the core scientific program) and with, in parallel, Hands-on sessions on ERCP, therapeutic EUS and EUS FNA (on special reservation and small additional fee).

The learning objectives of the course will be:

- 1. Evaluation of established and most recent endoscopy techniques, assessing their clinical utility in a multidisciplinary setting
- 2. Description of pre-therapeutic assessment and post-treatment follow up
- 3. Detailed technical teaching of various procedures
- 4. Providing scientific appraisal of technologies, evidence-based, with comparison with other approaches
- 5. Recognition of the role of endoscopy in digestive diseases and its interaction with gastroenterology, surgery, oncology, radiology and transplantation
- 6. Teaching on prevention and treatment of complications

The intended audience includes gastroenterologists, surgeons, internists and oncologists, nurses and GI assistants, MD in training and medical students, biomedical engineers and industry partners.

The format is based on live cases transmitted from Erasme Hospital, produced by a professional team in collaboration with experienced physicians and dedicated to provide the most comprehensive illustration of the procedures. All over the procedures, information summarizing the most recent publications will be displayed to reinforce the discussion based on scientific evidence.

The cases will be performed by world-renowned experts in collaboration with local physicians and nursing staff. Every procedure will be performed by at least 2 experts working together in order to ensure maximal interaction with the audience. The scientific programme also offers State-of-the-Art lectures, Questions and Answers sessions and one medical quiz.

The course language is English. No simultaneous translation will be provided.

HANDS-ON SESSIONS

SUNDAY, JUNE 16 (OPTIONAL)

After the positive feedback received from hands-on training attendees last June 2018, hands-on training sessions will be again organized on the occasion of the 37th GEEW. It will focus on therapeutic ERCP and EUS and will take place on Sunday, June 16th, 2019 in the afternoon at the Brussels Exhibition Centre, Auditorium 2000.

Registrations will be limited and are only available for a small additional fee of 50 € per session for those already registered to 37th GEEW.

Our course is intended for practicing gastroenterologists and for fellows in training with varying levels of training and experience. Our aim is to offer a focused and deliberate endoscopy practice in order to supply the attendees with practical skills to use, required core competencies and specific feedback, variable particularly important in the clinical practice. Therefore it is our pleasure and honor to welcome you to this hands-on endoscopy course.

4 hands-on training stations will be available: 2 dedicated to ERCP, 1 to EUS-FNA and 1 to EUS cyst drainage. Each station can accommodate up to 8 participants.

2 sessions on each station are organized:

- Session 1 : from 14:00 to 15:30

- Session 2 : from 16:00 to 17:30

Participants may register to 1 or 2 sessions. Registrations will be handled on a first come first served basis.

Techniques

ERCP: This workshop will feature tutored hands-on training of therapeutic ERCP procedures, including biliary and pancreatic cannulation, stenting, stone extraction, etc. These procedures will be performed on the Cook's state-of-the-art ERCP Trainer model, using real endoscopes and accessories. Thus participants can enhance their skills on basic cannulation, stricture management and stone management. We believe through this activity participants will gain further understanding of the fundamental procedures in therapeutic ERCP.

EUS-FNA: The trainees will be able to attain the learning outcomes of understanding the EUS anatomy as well as the skillful manipulation of the scopes to acquire the desired images.

EUS cyst drainage : EUS-guided drainage of cyst has become more feasible with the advent of LAMSs. The procedure will be done on biological simulators containing multiple cysts. The trainees will be able to understand the EUS guided drainage of a cyst followed by insertion of stents if needed.

Sessions are organised and supervised by Dr Mostafa IBRAHIM and Dr Nouran ROSHDY from the Roeya Training Center in Cairo, together with local experts.

- * Category "TRAINEES": only for those under the age of 32. A copy of the identity card or passport must be attached to the registration form.
- ** Category "NURSES": Nurses have to provide a certificate of their employer attesting they are indeed part of the nursing personnel.
- *** COMBINED REGISTRATION applies when 1 PHYSICIAN + 1 NURSE register together and at the same time. If registration is made at different time, each person has to register individually.

On-site registration does not necessarily entitle the participants to receive all congress material and metro tickets. One-day registration is not offered anymore. ESGE and WEO members cannot register online but only through the enclosed offline registration form.

□ ADDITIONAL FEE HANDS-ON TRAINING SESSIONS

Participants to hands-on sessions must be registered to the 37th GEEW core program. You may register to one or two hands-on sessions. As each session is limited to 8 participants for each working station, registrations will be handled on a first come first served basis.

Registration fee: 50 € / session

Upon registration, you will be requested to select the schedule of the session (1st session from 14:00 to 15:30 or 2nd session from 16:00 to 17:30) and the topic (ERCP, EUS FNA or EUS cyst drainage)

CANCELLATION POLICY

A refund of registration fees already paid, less 20 % for administrative expenses, will be made to any participant who becomes unable to attend the Workshop, if notice in writing is received by the administrative secretariat *prior to Friday, May 17th, 2019*. All refunds will be handled after the Workshop. Cancellations occurring on May 18 and after will be not be refunded.

NAME SUBSTITUTION

Name substitution received before April 19th, 2019 will be free of charge. From April 20 to May 17, a handling processing fee of 80 € per substitution will be charged. Name substitution or replacement occurring from May 18 will be invoiced as a full registration.

VISAS AND LETTERS OF INVITATION

Visas are not required for visitors from most European countries. For all other countries, visas are issued on a reciprocal basis. It is advisable to contact the local Belgian Embassy or Consulate or a Shengen diplomatic representation.

Usually, visa application must be done 4 to 6 weeks before the travel date. We strongly recommend you to register well in advance as our office will not intercede with local embassies to help shorten the delay. Invitation letters for visa purpose are only issued for duly registered participants having provided to the organisers their full contact details (security measures). Invitation letters requests have to be made to the organizing secretariat prior to May 17, 2019.

PAYMENT

An invoice with amount due (or invoice confirming amount paid if the payment has been made by credit card through the website) will be e-mailed within 48 hours after the registration procedure.

Payments are accepted <u>only in Euros</u> (European currency unit). Payments in other currencies will not be accepted. No registration will be processed without full payment:

- ▶ By bank transfer made to "ASBL Gastro-Entérologie et Endothérapie" on the bank account mentioned on the invoice. In order to avoid misunderstandings, participants are kindly requested to indicate CLEARLY their name and invoice number on transfer order forms. The Workshop secretariat will not be responsible for tracking transfers deposited without appropriate identification. Bank charges are the responsibility of the sender.
- ▶ By VISA or EUROCARD / MASTERCARD credit card only. The cardholder's name, card number and expiry date as well as the CVC code on the card (i.e. the last 3 digits on the back of the card) will be requested upon electronic payment.

Payments by cheque are not accepted.

CONFIRMATION OF THE REGISTRATION

HOW TO GET TO THE BRUSSELS EXHIBITION CENTRE
