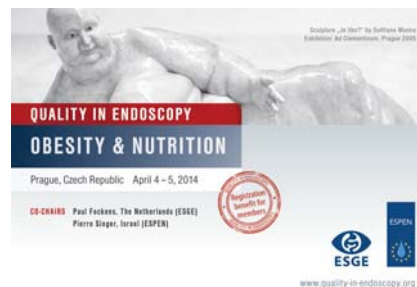

### ESGE Live Demonstration Workshop 2013

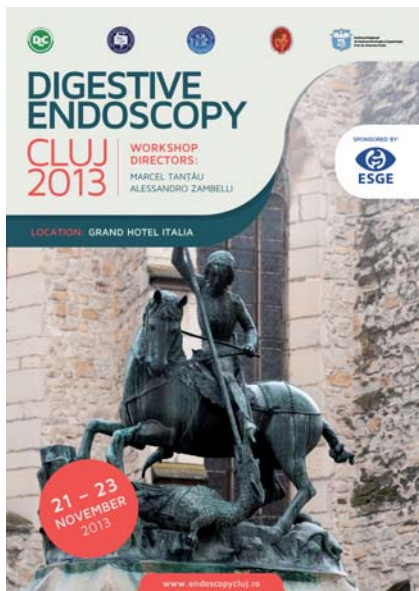
