The ESGE Quality Improvement Committee (ESGE QIC) is a recently launched ESGE initiative. Its mission is to improve the global quality of endoscopy and the delivery of patient-centered endoscopy services. It aims to promote a unifying theme of quality of endoscopy within ESGE activities, achieved by collaborating with other ESGE committees and working groups, and underpinned by a clear "quality improvement framework". ESGE QIC wishes to assist all endoscopy units and endoscopists in achieving these standards.

ESGE QIC has formed working groups for Upper GI Endoscopy (chair: Raf Bissshops), Small Bowel (chair: Cristiano Spada), Pancreatobiliary (chair: Dirk Domagk), Lower GI (chairs: Michal Kaminski & Michael Bretthauer) and Endoscopy Service (chair: Roland Valori). One of the first aims of ESGE QIC is to produce core evidence-based Quality Measures for endoscopy, outlining minimum and target performance standards for endoscopists.
