Research Grant Award



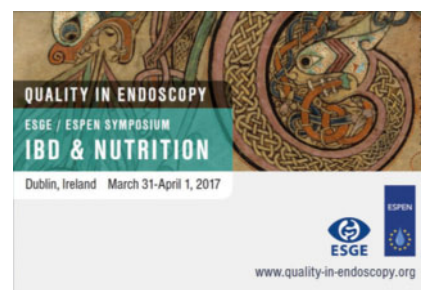

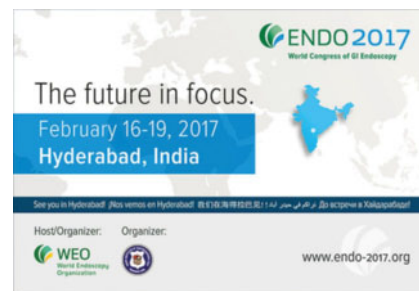
