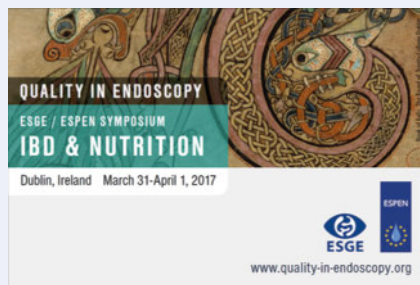

Endoscopic management of Barrett's esophagus: European society of Gastrointestinal Endoscopy (ESGE) Position Statement from Bas Weusten et al. Please read page 191 – 198.

In this issue ESGE is proud to publish a position statement on endoscopic management of Barrett's esophagus (BE). The statement was developed by a working group under the leadership of Prof Bas Weusten, Nieuwegein, The Netherlands.

A novel methodology was used in which four existing, recently published national guidelines served as the starting point for the current statement. This was done

in order to take advantage of the discussions of the scientific literature performed by the respective national BE guideline committees.

We wished to produce a practical guide for endoscopists delivering care for patients with BE. In addition, we aimed to contribute to a more cost-effective approach to the care of patients with BE, through reduction of the number of surveillance endoscopies for patients with a low risk of malignant transformation, and centralization of care for those with higher progression rates.

This statement contains recommendations on surveillance intervals, guidance on who not to survey or in whom surveillance could be stopped, and on management of dysplastic BE. In addition, criteria for referral of patients to a BE expert center are given, as well as requirements that should be met by BE expert centers
