Curriculum for ERCP and endoscopic ultrasound training in Europe:
ESGE Position Statement

This ESGE position statement comprehensively addresses, for the first time in Europe, a clear framework for the provision of training in both endoscopic retrograde cholangiopancreatography (ERCP) and endoscopic ultrasound (EUS). It encompasses the skills required prior to commencing training in ERCP and EUS, structured training for trainees to become independent endoscopists, and ways of ensuring competence is achieved and evidenced, with several practice recommendations.
