The ESGE Medtronic Research Award supports Artificial Intelligence (AI) research in the field of colonoscopy.

The ESGE Research Committee is particularly interested in research pertaining to (in no particular order): impact of AI on quality parameters at colonoscopy, differential impact stratified by endoscopist experience and setting, role of AI in training, identification of subtle neoplasia in patients at increased risk of colorectal cancer.

NEW! ESGE/ESGAR Guideline

The ESGE/ESGAR guideline update addresses the clinical indications for the two primary imaging alternatives to colonoscopy, CT colonography and colon capsule endoscopy.

The main focus is on incomplete colonoscopy, especially in organized screening programs, as well as on the potential of these alternative technologies in those patients for whom colonoscopy is not indicated or not medically feasible.

Finally, work-up strategies according to the findings from these minimally modalities are discussed.
