Endoscopic tissue sampling – Part 2: Technical guideline. *ESGE Guideline*

Adequate collection and handling of tissue samples during endoscopy is fundamental to pathological diagnosis for the digestive system. This is Part 2 of a two-part ESGE Guideline that provides evidence-based recommendations for optimizing and standardizing tissue collection during gastrointestinal endoscopy, and covers the lower gastrointestinal tract. Part 1 has been published separately and covers the upper gastrointestinal and hepatopancreatobiliary tracts.
